A condition of the booking is that any such structure larger than 3mx3m will require a risk assessment. The risk assessment must address the potential hazards to safety, to include possible risk of collision, trip hazards, consideration for strong winds, and the precautions taken. This must be submitted to the Sandbanks Beach Office not less than fourteen days prior to the booking.
