ADOPTION STATEMENT

THE NITROGEN REDUCTION IN POOLE HARBOUR SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with Regulations 11 and 14 of the Town & Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 that on 21 February 2017, the Borough of Poole Council adopted the Nitrogen Reduction in Poole Harbour Supplementary Planning Document (SPD).

The SPD provides the mitigation framework to ensure that new development will not have an adverse effect upon the Poole Harbour Special Protection Area. The SPD is to be used as guidance in the determination of relevant planning applications in support of local plan policy PCS29 in the Poole Core Strategy (2009).

Early engagement with interested parties and organisations took place during the drafting the SPD. The SPD was subject to public consultation between 9 October and 20 November 2015. The Council received 26 representations and modified the SPD as a result of the consultation feedback. A consultation statement sets out a summary of the main issues raised and how these have been addressed in the SPD. The modifications were reported to Council on 21 February 2017 and the SPD was subsequently adopted.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the Nitrogen Reduction in Poole Harbour SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted. The adopted SPD, the Adoption Statement and the full Consultation Statement setting out (a) representations received from the public consultation exercise, and (b) how the issues raised have been addressed in the SPD can be viewed on the Council's website and at the offices of Planning & Regeneration Services, Civic Centre, Poole, Dorset, BH15 2RU (Monday – Thursday 8.30am – 5.15pm) and (Friday 8.30am – 4.45pm).

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
