

Poole Housing Partnership Parking Regulations

These regulations are provided for tenants and leaseholders of Poole Housing Partnership, and freeholders at Sterte Close, and is split into three sections:

1. Regulations for everyone
2. Regulations specifically for residents and freeholders
3. Regulations specifically for residents' visitors

1. For Everyone

- a. You must have a valid Residents' permit, valid Visitor scratch card or valid Carers, Trade or Staff permit in order to park in designated Poole Housing Partnership (PHP) zones.
- b. Residents' permits and books of scratch cards may be purchased by residents from PHP's agent, Transportation Services, Borough of Poole, subject to completion of the application form and production of evidence to meet the set eligibility criteria, as set out on the application form. Carers, Trade and Staff permits will be issued by PHP and only when application criteria have been met. Further additional regulations apply to these PHP permits, provided separately.
- c. All Residents' permits are renewable annually and can only be purchased from Transportation Services at the Borough of Poole.
- d. Charges for permits are set by PHP every September for the coming year to cover the costs of providing the parking scheme.
- e. PHP permits and Visitor's scratch cards are only valid in PHP zones.
- f. Vehicles parked on PHP land not displaying a valid Resident, Trade, Staff or Carer permit or Visitor scratch card may be subject to the issue of a Penalty Charge Notice issued by PHP's agent, Transportation Services.
- g. You must not park any trailer, caravan, motor home or commercial vehicle in any PHP parking zone without first obtaining PHP's permission in writing. Permits will not be issued to vehicles exceeding three and a half tonnes.
- h. You and your visitors must not park anywhere that would obstruct emergency vehicles.
- i. Vehicles must be parked wholly within a marked bay. Any vehicle not parked within a marked bay (e.g. across lines, on footways, green spaces or grass verges) will be subject to the issue of a Penalty Charge Notice issued by Transportation Services.
- j. Only disabled drivers displaying a blue badge may park in bays marked 'Disabled' and must additionally display a valid Residents' permit. Blue Badge Holders with a Visitor's permit displayed may only use the Residents Disabled bay if between 10am and 4pm weekdays.
- k. Drop-off bays (when provided) are only available for 20mins stopping time; vehicles found to be exceeding this waiting time will be subject to the issue of a penalty charge notice.
- l. Buying a permit or scratch card does not guarantee the availability of a parking place.

- m. PHP reserves the right to withdraw any permit it considers is being misused. Photocopying or selling a permit or scratch card is deemed as misuse.
- n. PHP reserves the right to cap the number of permits and scratch cards in circulation, if PHP deems this necessary to ensure the effective management of the parking scheme.

2. Specifically For Residents and Sterte Close Freeholders

- a. You are entitled to one residents' permit per property per year if you are a car owner. The permit will be vehicle specific; however, you are entitled to have two vehicle registration numbers on one permit, subject to meeting the required criteria, as set out on the application form.
- b. If more than one registration number is shown on the permit, then it is your responsibility to ensure the permit is clearly shown on the vehicle that is parked on PHP land. Any Penalty Charge Notices issued for failing to display the permit will not be waived.
- c. Residents displaying a valid Resident permit may park in any available space but must additionally display their blue badge if using the disabled bay.

3. Specifically For Residents' Visitors

- a. Visitors must either display a valid Visitor's scratch card that only residents can purchase from PHP's agent, Transportation Services or a valid PHP Carers, Trade or Staff Permit.
- b. Visitor's scratch cards are sold in books of five daily cards. Residents may buy a maximum of 10 books (50 scratch cards) per year for their visitors' use. (Vulnerable residents may in some circumstances purchase additional visitor scratch card books. Please contact PHP for more information).
- c. Visitors displaying a valid scratch card may park in all bays between 10am and 4pm, (excepting disabled bays unless the visitor is displaying a blue badge) Monday to Friday. Visitors may only park in designated visitors parking at all other times.
- d. Carers, Trade or Staff displaying a valid PHP permit may park in any available bay between 10am and 4pm, Monday to Friday, (excluding the disabled bay) but may only park in designated visitors parking at all other times.
- e. PHP Carer's permits may be purchased by Care Agencies, Primary Care Team staff and individuals meeting the criteria in the application form.

NB.

Remember PHP permits and scratch cards are only valid in PHP zones. They are not valid on the Highway i.e. On-Street Resident bays, On-Street limited bays, Council Off-Street Car Parks or yellow lines.
