Sailing Vessel Parking Permit Application

If granted a permit I accept and shall honour the following conditions:

1. Permit period of 1 April 2021 to 31 October 2021 (or part thereof).
2. To park my vessel within the designated area (sign posted on the beach), found to the west of the Shore Road beach entrance.
3. To pay the Council a fee of £205.00 +VAT. You will be invoiced for the payment and once this has cleared you will be contacted to arrange collection of your permit from the Sandbanks Beach Office.
4. To ensure when the vessel is parked overnight that all halyards and up-hauls are kept away from the mast to eliminate noise.
5. To ensure that split rings are taped to prevent the mast of the vessel from falling down.
6. Park my vessel in such a manner that it will not prevent other permit holders from fulfilling their obligations and undertakings to conditions similar to those in the permit.
7. To immediately remove my vessel from the beach, if in the opinion of the Council it becomes dilapidated or a danger to the general public as a result of vandalism, misuse or neglect of maintenance. In the event that I do not remove the vessel within seven days on being requested so do I agree that the Council, without further notice of any kind to me, may do so, and that I hereby agree to pay within seven days all the Council's costs in the removing, storing and/or disposing of the vessel. Such costs will include all manual, transporting, administration and legal costs caused by the implementation of this clause of the Permit. I will not hold the Council responsible for any damage caused to the vessel as a result of the Council being given cause to remove the vessel.

8. To clearly display, on the mast, at all times the permit disc issued. In the event of loss a further application will be made and a new payment of £50.00 +VAT will be paid for a replacement permit disc.
9. Exercise appropriate care when launching or landing the vessel to ensure the safety of the general public.
10. Not allow my vessel to be used for trading on or from the beach.
11. That I shall not hold the Council responsible for any damage to or loss of my vessel as a result of vandalism, theft or any other activity, legal or otherwise carried out by members of the public.
12. That I shall indemnify and keep indemnified the Council against all liability directly or indirectly attributable to parking the vessel on the beach and for sailing the vessel off the beach (photocopy of insurance indemnification to be supplied on submission of application).
13. The permit is not transferable to any other vessel.
14. To conform to any reasonable verbal or written request of the Head of Leisure Services, Seafront Rangers Team or any other Council Officer acting on their behalf.
15. That in the event I do not conform with any of the conditions of the permit granted and continue to do so for a period of seven days after being given verbal or written notice of any such non conformity. The Council may withdraw my permit without refund to me for any unexpired time left within the permit period.
16. The decision of the Council in respect of all matters and disputes shall be final and binding on the permit holder or any person using the vessel with the permit holder's permission.
17. **Remove my vessel from the beach area on or before 31 October 2021.**
